


WHAT IS THE WESTRAC APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM?

WHO CAN APPLY?

To be considered for a WesTrac apprenticeship you must be a permanent resident or Australian Citizen and over 17 years of age at the time of commencement. Apprentices are required to get themselves to and from work each day. We recommend applying once you have a licence and reliable transport to be able to meet this requirement.

As part of the recruitment process you will be required to undergo a national police check and pre-employment medical if your application progresses to the final stages.


